Dr. Amir Borhani is an associate professor of Radiology (abdominal imaging) and surgery (organ transplant) at Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine in Chicago, Illinois, USA and also serves as the medical director of CT at that institution. Dr. Borhani's clinical and research works have been focused on liver imaging, imaging of organ transplants, and novel CT technologies and has served as principal investigator on several funded and multi-institutional studies on those topics. He is an active member of RSNA, SAR, and ACR LIRADS and currently serves as co-chair of LIRADS Technique working group, member of LIRADS steering committee, co-chair of SAR HCC Disease Focused Panel (DFP), and co-chair of SAR scientific program. Dr. Borhani is member of the editorial board of several major American radiology journals. He has co-authored 6 major radiology textbooks and more than 100 original research articles. He also has been the recipient of several teaching and mentorship awards from radiology residency programs at Northwestern University and University of Pittsburgh.
