

Dr. Antonio Esposito

Antonio Esposito, MD, is Full Professor of Radiology at Vita-Salute San Raffaele University and Deputy Scientific Director and Scientific Director of the Clinical Trial Center at IRCCS Ospedale San Raffaele in Milan, Italy. He also directs the Strategic Programme in Cardiovascular Radiology and Preventive Imaging and leads the Functional Unit of Cardiovascular Imaging and the Preclinical Imaging Facility at the same institution.

Dr. Esposito obtained his MD (1997–2003) and his specialization in Radiology (2003–2007), both summa cum laude, from Vita-Salute San Raffaele University. His research focuses on advanced MRI and CT applications in cardiovascular and oncologic imaging, spanning both clinical and preclinical models. He has authored more than 260 peer-reviewed publications, with over 9,000 citations and an H-index of 42.

He has played leading roles in national and European societies, including President (elected and re-elected) of the Italian College of Cardiac Radiology (SIRM) and board member of the Scientific Committee of the European Society of Cardiac Radiology (ESCR). Dr. Esposito serves as a reviewer for major journals such as JACC: Cardiovascular Imaging, European Radiology, and the European Heart Journal. His work has contributed to the development and validation of CT and MRI techniques for tissue characterization, myocardial inflammation and fibrosis, and cardiovascular risk stratification.
