Prabhakar Rajiah, MBBS, MD, is a Professor of Radiology at the Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota, specializing in cardiac CT and MRI and thoracic imaging. He obtained his medical degree and completed his diagnostic radiology residency at Madras Medical College in Chennai, India. He then pursued advanced subspecialty training with a fellowship in cardiac and body imaging at the University of Washington Medical Center in Seattle, followed by additional fellowships in cardiovascular and musculoskeletal imaging at the Cleveland Clinic Foundation in Ohio.

Dr. Rajiah's clinical and research work focuses on the optimal use of CT and MRI for the evaluation of cardiovascular and thoracic diseases, including advanced techniques for functional and quantitative imaging. He has authored more than 170 peer-reviewed manuscripts, nine books and 48 book chapters, and has contributed extensively to the education of radiologists worldwide through reviews and practice-oriented articles in leading journals such as *Radiographics* and the *Journal of Thoracic Imaging*.

An active leader in academic radiology, Dr. Rajiah was named the **2021 RSNA William R. Eyler Editorial Fellow**. He serves on the editorial boards of *Radiology: Cardiothoracic Imaging*, *Cardiovascular Diagnosis and Therapy* and the *Indian Heart Journal*, and is associate editor of *Current Problems in Diagnostic Radiology* and the *Journal of Computer Assisted Tomography*. He is also a member of the RSNA Subcommittee for Cardiac Imaging of the Annual Meeting Program Planning Committee, the *Radiographics* Cardiac Imaging panel, and the RSNA Education Committee, in addition to multiple institutional committees at Mayo Clinic.
