Juan Álvarez-Linera Prado, MD, PhD is a Spanish neuroradiologist and Head of Diagnostic Imaging at Hospital Ruber Internacional (Madrid), where he has led the implementation of advanced MRI since 1991. Trained in Medicine (University of Oviedo) and Radiology in Madrid, he completed further specialization in MRI and neuroradiology in Columbus, USA. A pioneer of 3T MRI in Spain (first installation in 2001) and an ESNR European Board-certified neuroradiologist, his work focuses on advanced neuroimaging for epilepsy, brain tumors, and neurodegenerative diseases. He has led pediatric epilepsy presurgical imaging collaborations for two decades, introduced PET–MRI fusion for focal epilepsy in Spain, and has delivered extensive national and international teaching. He has published ~100 scientific papers, authored two neuroradiology books, participated in 100+ clinical trials, and received multiple research and teaching awards, including honorary membership of the Spanish Society of Neuroradiology (2024).
